CVSA Brake Check Sept. 11th-17th

During the week of September 11 – 17, law enforcement agencies will be conducting inspections of commercial motor vehicles looking for out-of-adjustment brakes, brake system and anti-lock braking system violations .Brake-related violations made up 43% of all service violations conducted during last year's Road Check. Over 3.4 million brakes have been inspected by CVSA since 1998.

Brake safety week includes, but is not limited to, the following components:

- Brake System Components
- Air or Hydraulic Fluid Leaks
- Worn Linings
- Pads
- Drums
- Rotors
- ABS Indicator Lamps
- Loose or Missing Parts



* Defective or out-of-adjustment brakes will result in vehicle immediately being put out of service *

Many inspections occurring during the week will be full Level 1 Inspections along with the 10 jurisdictions that conduct Performance-Based Brake Testing, according to the CVSA. 2015's inspections showed that over 12% vehicles were placed out of service during the entirety of the Brake Check week. Make sure you are prepared when hitting the road on September 11th.
